Outrigger names Trump veteran CEO

Hawaii-based Outrigger Hotels and Resorts named Jeff Wagoner president and CEO.

Wagoner, most recently executive vice president of Trump Hotels, will start April 26, replacing <u>Scott Dalecio</u>, who has been Outrigger's interim CEO since early 2017.

Dalecio is co-founder and CEO of KSL Resorts, <u>which purchased Outrigger</u> in November 2016; he will become executive chairman.

Wagoner also had senior positions at Wyndham Hotel Group, including president of Wyndham Hotel Group Management, EVP of global brand services and president of Wyndham Hotels and Resorts.



"Jeff is a proven leader with the operational strength and industry intelligence to successfully steer Outrigger Hotels and Resorts as we further expand the global footprint of this iconic hospitality brand," said Dalecio, according to a statement.

Outrigger's portfolio includes nine resorts in Hawaii, Fiji, Thailand, Guam, Mauritius and the Maldives, and 27 owned and/or managed hotels, resorts and vacation condominiums.

"It's a tremendous time of reinvestment and growth for Outrigger Hotels and Resorts and I am honored for the opportunity to be a part of this new chapter," said Wagoner, according to a statement.
