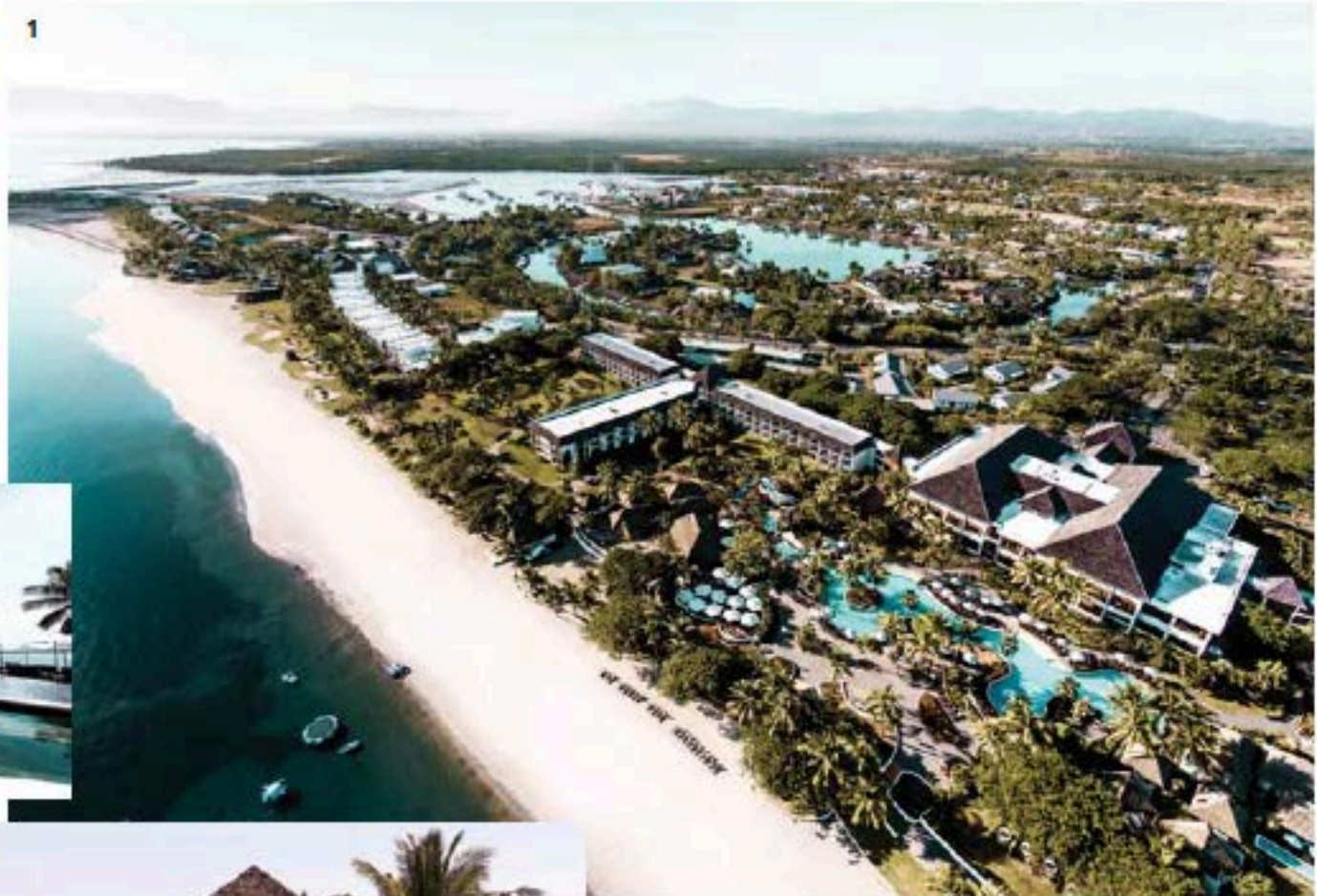


Think you know Fiji? *think again*

Live the easy life

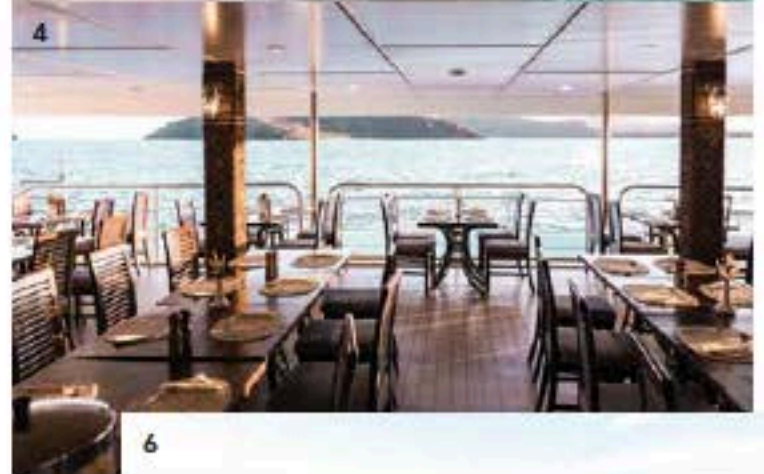
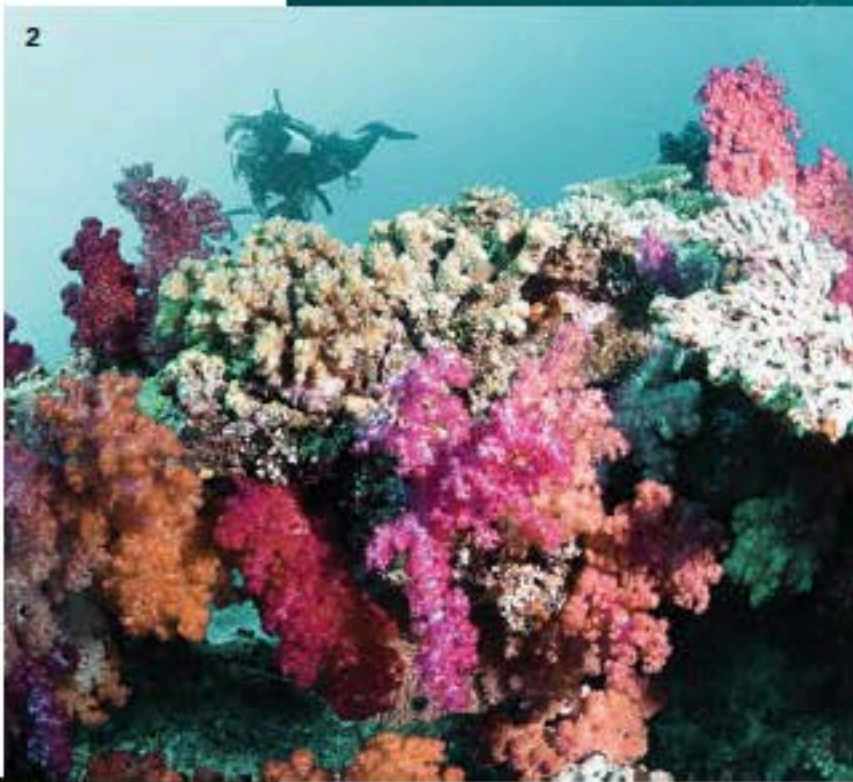

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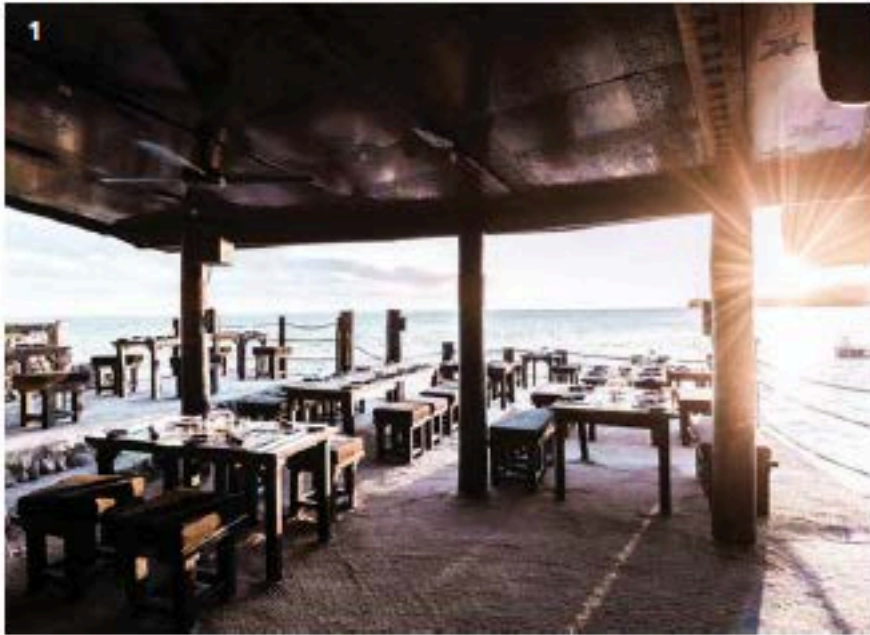

The idyllic Coral Coast on the island of Viti Levu, a short drive from Nadi, is a bustling hub and the perfect place to get a glimpse into traditional Fiji. Start at Sigatoka markets (you'll probably want to return daily!) to pick up fresh, still-in-the-shell coconut water, local produce and handicrafts. A stay at The Warwick Fiji or the Outrigger Fiji Beach Resort puts you in a great location to explore your surrounds, including the spectacular Biausevu waterfall and taking in the sunsets at the Sigatoka Sand Dunes National Park.
