The move to the Kalihi and Palama district aims to uplift the community through public art. Founder Jasper Wong, who has a personal connection to the neighborhood and has taught art classes at Palama Settlement, a community center and cornerstone of the area, experienced the immediate need for support in the community.

"Our partners at OUTRIGGER and Hawaiian Aroma Caffe are incredibly aligned in our mission of supporting emerging artists both locally and globally," said Jasper Wong, co-founder of World Wide Walls.
